Department of Botany of Shree Shivaji Arts, Commerce & Science College, Rajura organised a field visit to a perennial lake, Bamanwada for B. Sc. II, Sem. IV. on 14th September 2018.

Objectives of the visit:

- > To study diversity of aquatic plants
- > To understand the habitat
- > To understand the *Singhada* cultivation

Visit:

As per the planning, 25 students of B. Sc. Sem. IV and two faculties visited a perennial lake situated near Bamanwada village. Students observed diversity of hydrophytes and other associated plants present around the lake. Students collected different types of hydrophytes and studied their aquatic adaptations. Students also interacted with local people to understand about the cultivation practices and processing of local edible fruit Singhada (*Trapha natans*).
