Details of the Workshop:

This workshop was organized in order to train the faculties for the application of various online teaching tools like Google meet, Zoom, Google Classroom, document reader, screen recording and make the online classes effective and interesting. As the pandemic situation was ongoing necessity of online classes was strongly felt and hence this workshop was organized.

Session 1: Understanding the applications of Google Meet, Zoom and creation of Google forms for registration or online assessment

Dr. B. M. Reddy, IQAC Coordinator during his presentation taught how to use google meet, Zoom application for online teaching. He practically demonstrated by creating link for new class, beginning of lecture on google meet. Similarly he also informed about how to add extensions in Google Chrome like extension for Attendance, Grid view of participants. A

thorough demonstration on the use of Google Meet and Zoom was provided. At the end, he also guided on how to create Google forms for the purpose of registration, feedback, online evaluation during unit tests etc. Document reader and its application for the display of textual information in science stream classes was also provided.

Session 2: Understanding Google Classroom

Dr. A. M. Chilke during his presentation guided on how to create a new google classroom, how to add students, how to provide reading material, assignments for students.

Session 3: Recording of lectures using online applications/softwares

Mr G. D. Balki guided on the use of screen recorder especially OBS which is useful for recording of lecture for those students who cannot attend online lectures due to technical issues. He guided on how to record lecture with the use of OBS.

Sessioon 4: Application of You tube for posting lectures

Mr Sanjay Shende guided the participants on how to post our recorded lectures in the category of unlisted videos and public videos.

At the end of the workshop, the faculties practised on computers and laptops and tried the applications of Google meet, zoom, Google forms, OBS etc.
